- 1. Call to Order at 6:33pm.
- 2. Agenda: Rebecca made a motion to approve the Agenda and Carol seconded. Agenda approved.
- 3. Meeting Minutes: Rebecca made a motion to approve Meeting Minutes from January 18, 2024. Mindy seconded. Meeting Minutes approved.
- 4. No public remarks other than to welcome Catherine Mojo, a potential new commission member.
- 5. Old Business:
 - a. Review of Capstone Grant Submissions: Cadence Thibodeau withdrew her Capstone grant application, so we have \$200 to spend elsewhere. Holly Pugo applied for a Capstone grant and will be invited to present her proposal (East Hampton Food Bank) in person or by Zoom if necessary.
