## Winterize Guidelines

All homeowners are encouraged to maintain a year-round electric power supply to the grinder pump. (Recommended)

However, should temporary (seasonal) shutoff of electrical service to a residence be taken, the following procedures shall be followed:

- 1. Winterize all plumbing fixtures in the usual manner, except for a single sink/faucet.
- 2. Turn on the water in the sink long enough to cause the grinder pump to start.
- 3. Turn water off once the grinder pump starts.
- 4. Allow grinder pump to shut off automatically. This purges the system of solids and leaves it filled with a minimum volume of clean water.
- 5. Winterize the sink/faucet.

Upon returning to the residence be sure that the power to the alarm panel and pump is turned on and proceed with normal use. Please note, should a resident wish to terminate power to the grinder pumps, adverse impacts that could occur may result in a claim from the WPCA for the grinder pump repair or replacement if the above procedures are not followed.
