Mr. Foran did an agent review of a proposed 38x40 barn in the upland review area located at 210 Tartia Road and found it to be acceptable with the following conditions: **E&S controls (if deemed necessary by town staff), which may including silt fence and/or hay bales, swales should be shown and reviewed by Town Staff prior to construction. Notify Town Staff prior to activity, and Town Staff must be advised upon completion**

*Mr. Wilson moved, and Mr. Boule seconded to approve the Application of the Town of East Hampton, 20 East High Street, reconstruction of Flanders Road, Phase II, noting there are no impacts to the wetlands; conditions are all E&S controls are in place prior to construction and inspected by town staff. The motion carried unanimously.*
