



Questions:

How does the Town Manager prioritize projects each year for the town? (For instance, there are concerns with the conditions of the police department, the lake, etc.) Who determines what gets done? And is there a 5- or 10-year plan for the town? If there is a long-term plan, is it currently being implemented?

Answer:

Projects are basically prioritized on what gets funded through the budgeting process. When reviewing Capital, the Town Manager prioritizes health, safety and welfare items first. In some instances we have had to prioritize items ahead of this as a result of legal and compliance requirements or even to ensure basic operability of departments. There is both a 5 year capital plan and a 10 year capital plan. Unfortunately, it is not funded completely every year and as a result, the unfunded items get pushed further and further out.
