Wade Russo Theater Chat presentation — Wade Russo the summer music director at the Goodspeed Opera House has offered to do a non-partisan presentation on the influence of politics on the American musical. A potential date is Tuesday, Aug. 14 at the East Hampton Public Library. Commissioners discussed hosting such an event and whether the topic of politics is appropriate. The commission approved hosting the event on Aug. 14. Five in favor, one with reservations about the idea.

Art Open House /Open Studio – Some local artists have asked about the event. Saturday Oct. 28 is the potential date with an exhibit space for those who don't have a studio to open – possibly the Goff House, Cong. Church or another larger venue.
