- a. Kevin Reich's idea to start a weekly artist shed/marketplace could tie into artist Kristen Walsh's idea to hold an art contest/initiative in the village center where art would be exhibited in business windows. We will invite her to our next meeting on Nov. 15.
- b. Shauna Lee Lange has resigned from the commission. We have two vacancies. Members discussed the lack of volunteers to boards and commissions. EHACC should have 9 members but now has 7. Should we have alternates and go down to 7? Many of the town's commissions are challenged in getting volunteers to serve.
- c. Open Studio the event was cancelled for Oct. 27 due to a lack of artist participation. We might try again next year. More publicity needed, perhaps a paid advertisement. Participating artists need to let the commission know if they will participate in a timely manner.
- d. Artist Open House in September not a big turnout but the conversation was great with local artists sharing about their work and technique. Overall the event was a great networking opportunity. Perhaps the commission should host more of these types of events.

New Business

A. Grants – see below

Budget – Now that the town budget has passed, we will have a working budget. Ellen Paul told us we have been budgeted \$2000 although the recent documentation shows \$1500. Carol will stop by the finance department and find out. Tentatively we will continue with our student art program (\$250), the art purchase award (\$300) and the grant program (two at \$300 for \$600 total). Open Studio won't be until next fall. That leaves \$350 in the budget. The web site is paid for this year.
