Call to Order: Chairman Philhower called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. in the Town Hall 2nd Floor Meeting Room and via Zoom.

Approval of Minutes: A motion was made by Mr. Feegel, seconded by Dr. Brown, to approve the minutes of the January 18, 2022 and January 25, 2022 Capital Committee minutes as presented. Voted (5-0).

Continued Discussion & Possible Determination of Future Capital Projects

Mr. Cox provided an overview of the updated listing of projects. He reviewed available balances and the 2034 Town Manager proposal.

Mr. Philhower noted the Expanded Storage and Salt Shed will be removed from the plan. He would rather see a real building instead of a tent hoop building. A revised plan for a building will move to 2025. The rescue boat will be included. Funds were lowered for the turnout gear, air bottles and dry hydrants. Cruisers will be cut back to 1 instead of 2. The Board of Education technology was lowered by \$155,000. Paving for 94 Main Street was removed. Tennis court reconstruction was moved to 2024. A final worksheet will be prepared for the next meeting for approvals.
