# **Update on Status of Current Capital Projects**

## **Review of Future Capital Projects**

Matt Walsh, Director of Public Works, was present to review the capital items for his department. He discussed Edgerton Street drainage with a cost based on in-house work. The new excavator would be necessary for that project. The pavement portion of the project would be done around July 2021. Mr. Turner suggested North Maple Street for sidewalk replacement. There was a general discussion of vehicles and buildings/garages. It was noted the Town should look at future needs for a DPW facility. Also, the current street sweeper will be in need of replacement in the near future.

Jeremy Hall, Director of Parks & Recreation, was present to review the capital items for his departments. The High School baseball field was reviewed again noting the quotes range from \$70,000 to \$600,000. Research is currently being done on the topsoil. UConn is doing research on the current drainage. He also reviewed the water quality projects at Sears Park that will be funded through the Conservation-Lake's 319 grant.

Next week's meeting will focus on public safety departments.
