Updates:

- DFC Grant
 - o Less attendance for drug take back than previous years
 - Trunk or treat high turnout
 - Narcan training by the APW on 11/18/21 at 12:00PM
 - o River east add posted
- LPC Grant:
 - Grant finalized and approved
- Parent/Guardian survey
 - o Initial presentation by Emiliy Melnick conducted on survey outcomes
 - o N=109
 - Most respondents from high school
 - 10th grade specifically
 - School is the highest reported stressor
 - 50% reported feeling stressed by school amongst 10th graders
 - o Parents reported high likelihood that their child would talk to them about drug use
 - For next year's survey: separate drug use from alcohol use
 - Parents' perceived somewhat low alcohol use in the last 30 days amongst their child's peers
 - Parents' underestimating youth drinking behaviors
 - Comparison data between youth and parent/guardian survey

- About a 10% increase of actual drinking behavior by youth compared to their parent's perceptions of their behaviors
- Suggestions from the data
 - Curriculums to assist parents in understanding how to converse to their child to discourage use
 - Incentives/consequences, and how to keep the dialogue going over time
 - Provide specific and actionable recommendations from the public health literature
