Services

EAST HAMPTON COMMUNITY CAFE

The Estuary provides Middlesex County Congregate meals and Meals On Wheels. Meals continue to be offered at 12pm Monday through Friday. You still can sign up by calling or signing up on the kiosk at the desk for your meals or by using MyActiveCenter.com

This Elderly Nutrition program is funded by the federally funded Title III grant. All participants are required to complete a Form 5 registration (ask the café manager), prior to making a reservation. Reservations need to made at least 24 hours in advance. A \$3.00 donation is requested, although no one age 60+ will be turned away for lack of donation.

River Valley Transit

RVT is a transit agency operated by the Estuary Transit District. RVT provides a variety of services including traditional fixed routes, ADA Paratransit, Dial-A-Ride, and On-Demand Xtra mile.

The service area encompasses most of Middlesex County and services 17 municipalities. Please see the Fare schedule in the RVT brochure, located in the info center.

All services are open to the general public with no age or disability restrictions. Dial-A-Ride senior 60+ by donation transportation is made possible by a grant from the Senior Resources Agency on Aging with Title III funds made available under the Older Americans Act.

Dial-A -Ride Senior Fare requires pre-registration by calling 860-510-0429.

XtraMile Shuttle Rides Coming to East Hampton!

XtraMile is an on-demand ride sharing service that anyone can use to get around town on their schedule. River Valley Transit is excited that the Belltown area of East Hampton will be one of our next XtraMile zones. Whether you're looking to explore downtown, shop at Stop & Shop, visit Sears Park, or anything else in Belltown, we got you covered.

XtraMile allows riders to request a ride when they want to be picked up by calling: 860-510-0429 or by using our XtraMile by RVT app available for both iPhone & Android.

Once a ride is booked a driver in a shuttle bus will come and pick you up and drop you off at your desired location as quickly as possible. Average wait times are between 10-20 minutes but can vary based on the driver's location and how busy the service is.

The fare for a one-way trip is \$1.75 and \$3.50 round trip respectively. Service will start on May 28th, 2024, Monday-Friday 7am-6pm and Saturday 8am-5pm.

Seniors 60+ may ride on a donation only basis, preregistration required
