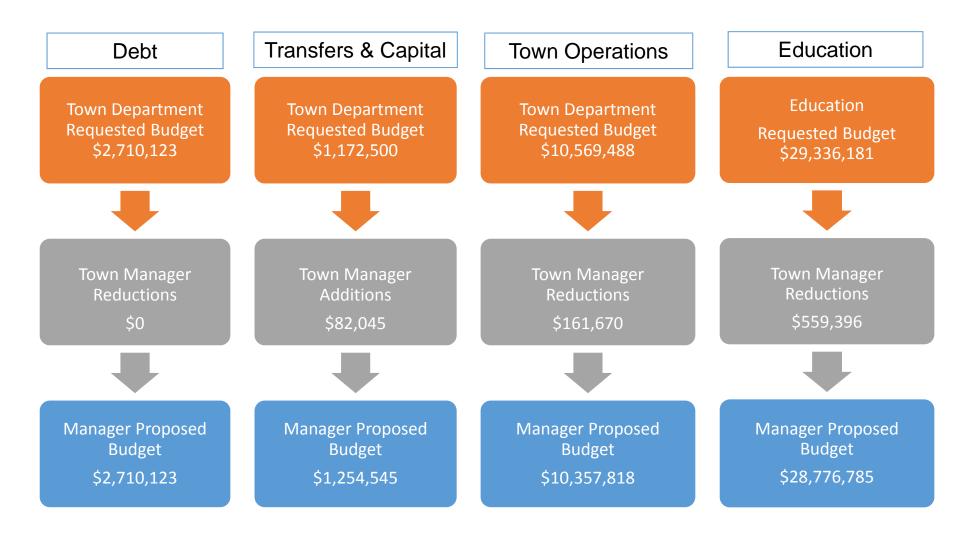

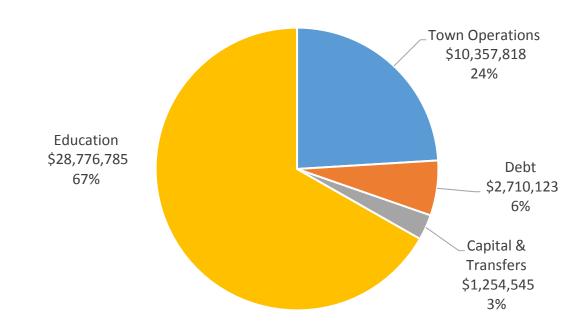

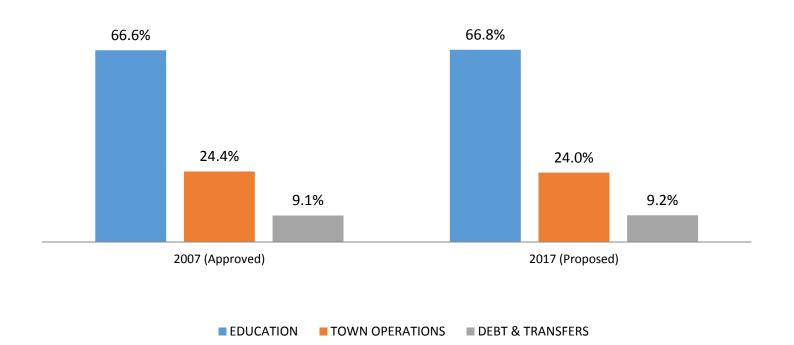


Proposed Spending Plan by Major Function Total Budget Request: \$43,099,271



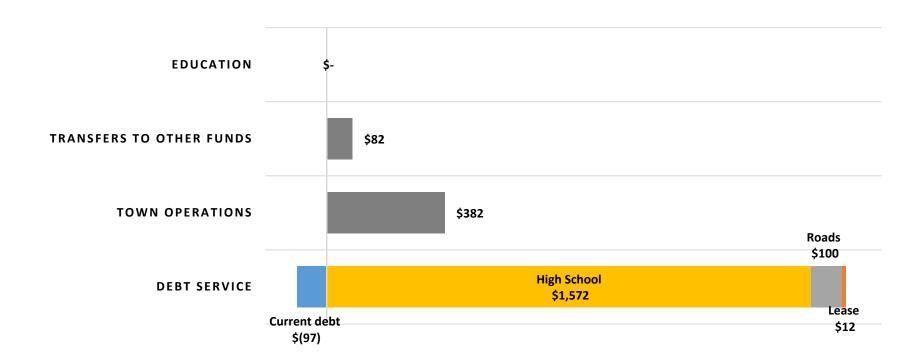


Budget Allocation 2007 vs. 2017

• Pension (Estimate): \$11,089

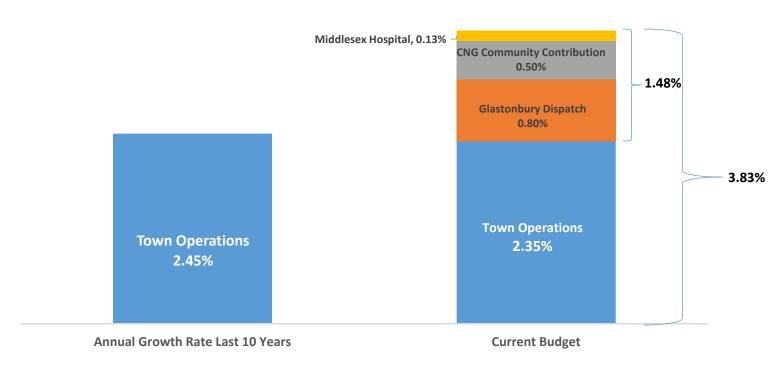
• Workers compensation and liability insurance: \$15,815

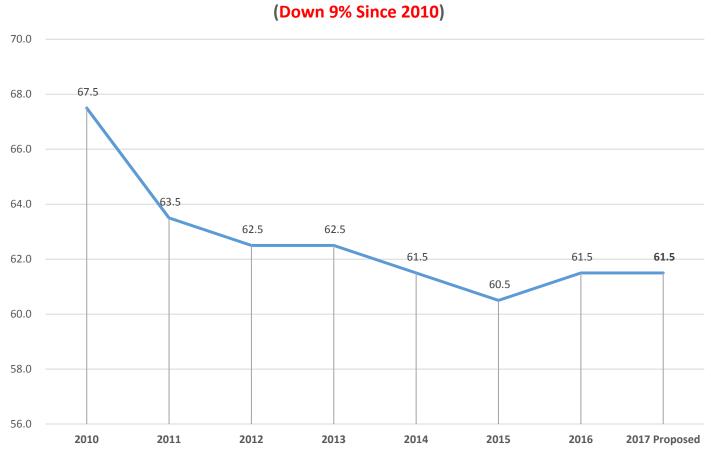
Town Operations (Excludes Debt & Transfers)





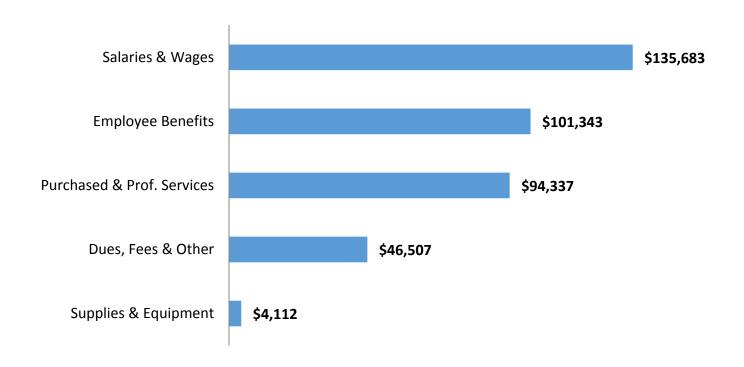

Full Time Employees



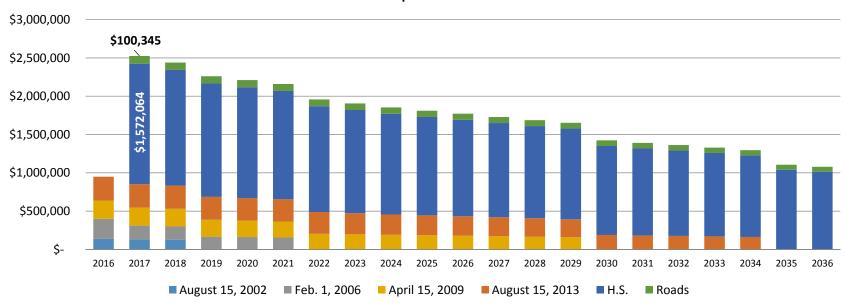


Town Operations Proposed Budget Change Total Change: \$381,982



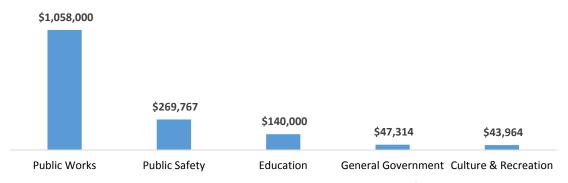


Debt Paydowns by Issue Principal & Interest

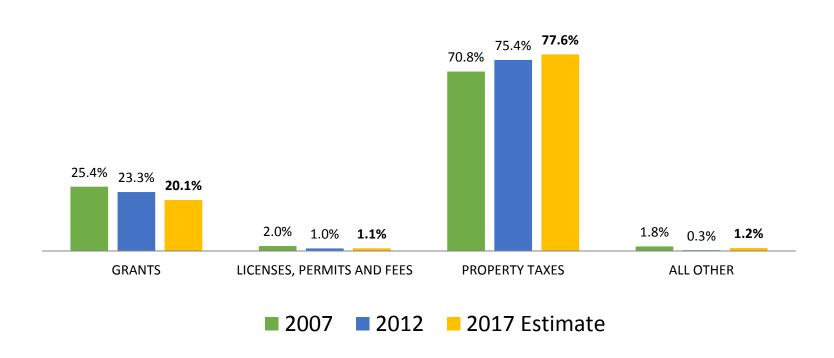
Revenues

We have adjusted our estimates in the following revenue categories:

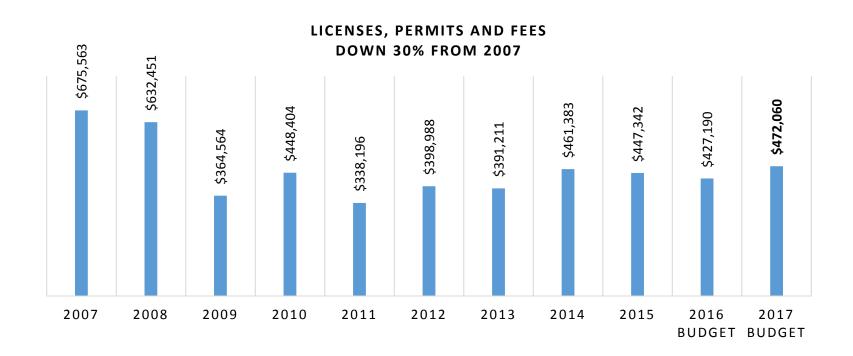
- Licenses, Permits & Fees \$44,870
 - Building activity in Town has begun to increase.
- Grants \$262,011
 - The large increase in grants is due to a new state sales tax revenue sharing grant. All other grant estimates are based on the Governor's February 2016 statutory formula grant estimates.
- Delinquent tax collections (\$78,500)
 - Minor slowdown in our back tax collections. The Tax Office will continue to aggressively pursue delinquent taxes through all possible means.



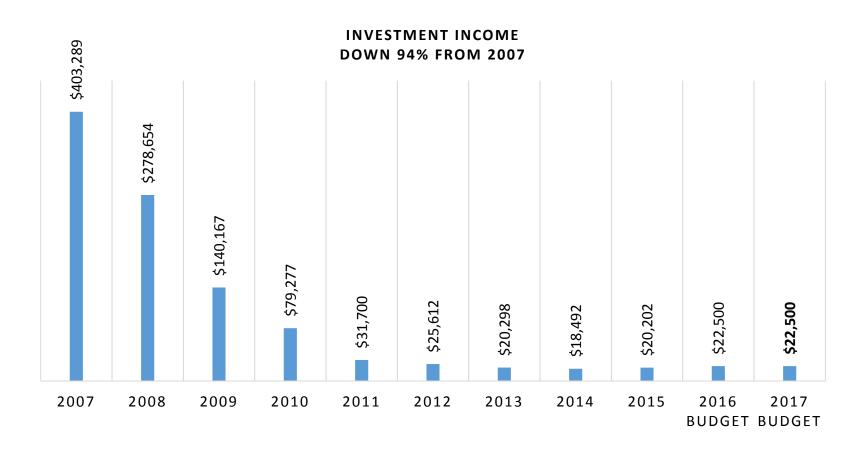
% of Total Revenue







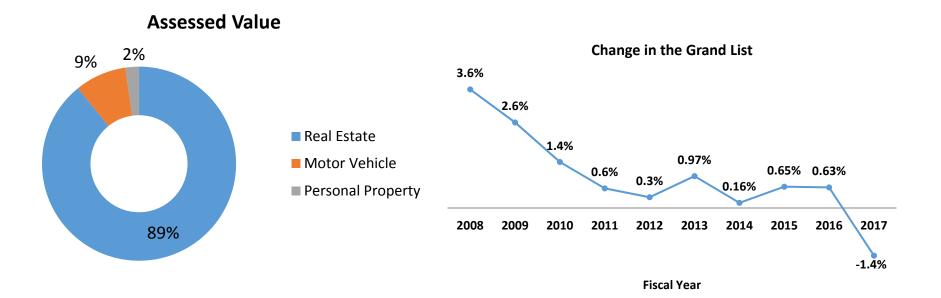




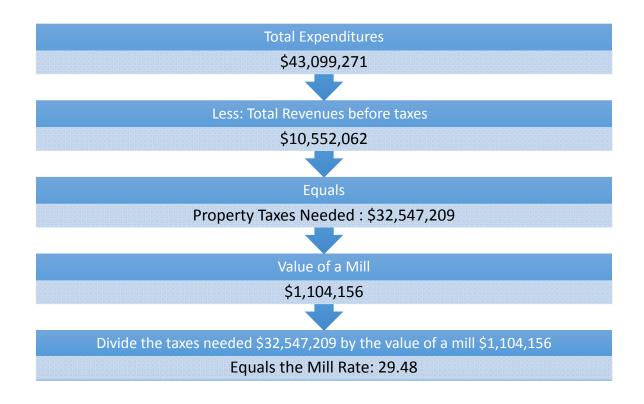


Grand List

- Grand list decreased by 1.44% or \$16.5M primarily as a result of property revaluation.
- New grand list growth of approx. \$6.5M helped soften the overall grand list decrease.

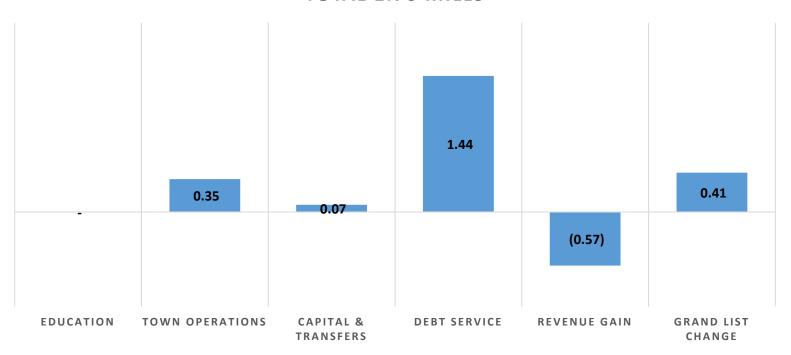








MILL VALUE TOTAL 1.70 MILLS
