
REVENUES

- GOVERNMENT GRANTS 19.6%
- FEES FOR SERVICE 1.1%
- TAXES 78.1%
- OTHER 1.2%

- POLICE
 - K-9 program
 - Continued funding for new officer position
 - Partner with the BOE for an SRO
- FIRE
 - 2nd UTV to replace 1950 Forestry vehicle
 - Company 1 parking lot replacement
 - Continue funding of Turnout gear and SCBA Bottle replacement
- FIRE MARSHAL/ EMERGENCY MGMT
 - New CT Fire Safety Code
- YOUTH & FAMILY/SOCIAL SERVICES
 - Expecting a new Director soon
 - Continue Counseling services
 - Continue Heat and Electric subsidy

 - Sears Park Parking lot replacement
 - High School Baseball field repair
 - Support 250th Anniversary
- LIBRARY
 - Continue and enhance online offerings
 - Further coordinate programs with community partners
 - Support 250th Anniversary
- SENIOR CENTER
 - Promote a more active lifestyle for Older Adults
 - Promote Older Adults awareness of health, nutrition, financial, social, and recreational wellbeing
 - Provide out of district medical transportation from 1 trip a month to 4 trips a month



ADMINISTRATION

- TOWN CLERK
 - Implement credit cards
 - Email reminder cards for dog renewal rather than mail
 - Purchase additional minute books and paper
- COLLECTOR OF REVENUE
 - Investigate check scanner for better customer service
 - 98.6% Collection rate
- ASSESSOR
 - RFP for Personal Property audits
 - Mapping improvements
 - Data sharing between departments
- FINANCE
 - Financial Dashboard and Citizen Transparency
 - Document capture automation and content management
 - Reduce bank accounts by 25%
