#### **Communications**

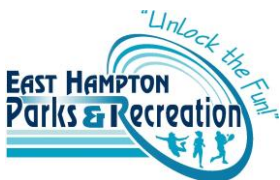
- a. New Town Manager hired and started on September 3<sup>rd</sup>
