5. Applications:

A. Application ZBA-20-001, James Bansemer, 28 Tennyson Rd., to reduce the side setback from 15' to 4.5' to rebuild, improve and expand the existing entrance and exit. Map 10A/Block 81/Lot 71. Mr. Bansemer of 87 O'Connell Rd. in Colchester presented. The existing stairs are 18 years old and do not meet the current building codes. The intent is to improve the stairs to make them safer and to create more room at the landing so there is room to maneuver. The proposed plan is to expand and improve the existing entrance without getting closer to the property line. The applicant supplied photos of what exists and what is being proposed. There were no public comments.
