

Wetlands Narrative for 58 Middle Haddam Road

Natural Aquatics LLC has been contracted for the construction of an inground gunite swimming pool. The property consists of two levels divided by a five foot tall granite wall. The proposed pool shall be built on the higher elevation of the property. The location of the pool currently is a level, mowed lawn with no vegetation. Currently, at the proposed pool location is an existing septic field that will need to be moved in order to build the pool. The scope of the work shall consist of silt fencing with returns along the granite wall and the perimeter of the dirt stock piles. Installation of a new septic field at an approved location. Construction of the pool shall commence upon the completion of the new septic field. Any excess fill shall be removed from site. Upon the completion of the septic and pool, property shall be remediated back to a new lawn. Silt fencing shall be maintained during construction and will not be removed until lawn is germinated. The proposed pool location was determined due to the lots size restrictions. Contractor will not be entering the lower level of the property. The pool shall be equipped with a cartridge filter which will prevent backwashing of pool water.
