EXHIBIT "B" BERNER SELECTIVE TIMBER HARVEST CUTTING SCHEDULE / SEDIMENTATION AND EROSION CONTROL PLAN

Scotland Hardwoods (A Rossi Company) plans to conduct a logging operation on approximately 31.6 total acres owned by Doris Berner located off Abbey Road Ext. in East Hampton, Ct.. This land is further identified by the East Hampton Assessors Map #6, Block #5 and Lot #17. A one to three man logging crews operating a log skidder will cut and skid the logs to one main yarding area. From this yarding area a tri-axle log truck will pick up the logs and exit the property via Stagecoach Run Road. Regular working hours are from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday thru Saturday. The property boundaries have been marked with fluorescent pink flagging and the main skid roads have been identified with blue. Approximately one hundred thousand board feet of sawtimber has been marked for removal. All trees to be removed have been marked with blue paint about 4 feet above the ground and at the base of each stump. Concerning the harvest area, about 70% of the trees 14 inches D.B.H. (diameter at breast height) and larger, will be removed from the property. Oak, Ash, Black Birch, Tulip Poplar, Hard Maple and Hickory represent the species of trees involved with the harvest. All tops concerning the harvested trees will be reduced to within five feet of the ground level. It is estimated that about four to six weeks will be required to complete the project. We hope to start the harvest during the fall of 2019.

Two drainages will have to be crossed concerning the harvest. It is planned to use portable bridges in combination with wood poles and or brush mats concerning the crossings. Upon completion of the harvest waterbars will be installed where necessary on the main skid roads. For further details concerning this activity please refer to Exhibit "A".



- 10. <u>Arbitration.</u> In the event of a dispute arising in connection with any matter concerning this Agreement or the obligations of the parties hereunder, the final decision shall rest with arbitrators, one of whom shall be hired by the Seller and another by the Buyer and in case the two shall disagree, they shall hire, at the expense of Seller and Buyer, a third arbitrator, and the decision of the majority of the three arbitrators shall be final. Any demand for arbitration must be made within twelve (12) months of the expiration of the Term of this Agreement.
- 11. Permits, Approvals and Environmental. Buyer shall have the authority to apply to any local, state or Federal agency having jurisdiction over the timber harvest provided for in this Agreement on behalf of Seller. It shall be the responsibility of the Buyer to obtain such approvals. In the event that the approvals are not obtained, this Agreement shall be null and void and all sums paid by Buyer to Seller shall be refunded by Seller, prorated if the harvest was commenced and timber was removed. In the event that Buyer is prevented by any local, state, federal authority or private person or agency from commencing or completing the timber harvest provided for under this Agreement by reason of an environmental or other condition, this Agreement shall be null and void and all sums paid by Buyer to Seller, prorated if the harvest was commenced and timber was removed, shall be refunded by Seller to Buyer.
- 12. <u>Assignment.</u> Buyer may not assign its rights and obligations in whole or in part under this Agreement without the prior written consent of Seller.
