I was able to conduct an onsite visit for the proposed Dexter's Tunes Tale & Ales serving beer and wine at 91 Main Street in East Hampton, CT with owner Sheila Mullen. During this visit we discussed the possibility of getting an approval at this location only. In order to get approval the following items would need to be addressed:

- Ventilation in the Restroom would need to be functioning
- A hand sink and a mop sink would need to be installed
- Wall behind the sinks would need to be light in color, non-absorbent, smooth, and easily cleanable (i.e: FRP)
- Baseboards throughout the establishment would need to be heavily coated with Polyurethane to ensure they are non-absorbent
- The hand sink would need to have splash guards
- The hot water in the restroom shall not exceed 115°F
- A full plan review application shall be filed with associated fees
- When the plan review is complete owner should apply for a Class I food service license and pay associated fees
- At the end of construction owner shall contact Chatham Health for a pre-operational inspection where we will issue a current license
