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**ANNUAL CONFERENCE TO BE CANCELLED/

In light of the continuing COVID 19 restrictions on large gatherings, a decision has been made to cancel the 73rd Annual Conference of the Connecticut Federation of Planning and Zoning Agencies. This decision was made after conferring with the Aqua Turf staff and reviewing current CDC and CT Public Health protocols regarding social distancing. This is very disappointing but public health is of the utmost importance at this critical point.

We are sincerely grateful to the entire membership of The Connecticut Federation of Planning and Zoning Agencies for your continued support during these difficult times. Despite this extended period of restrictions, towns across Connecticut have continued to address zoning concerns and the CFPZA has continued to disseminate the most up-to-date information about current trends and changes to zoning laws which affect the decisions of land use commissions.

While the Conference has been cancelled, a Webinar will be scheduled for April at which time the Connecticut Federation of Planning and Zoning Agencies would like to honor those Commission members who have attained service milestones with Length of Service and Lifetime Achievement Awards.

Those persons who have served 12 or more years as a member of a planning commission, zoning commission, planning and zoning commission or zoning board of appeals are eligible to receive a Length of Service Award. The twelve years of service may be a combination of time spent as a member of all four agencies. The twelve years, however, must be continuous from year to year.

Individuals who have served at least twenty-five (25) years in the area of land use, either as a member of a zoning agency or as staff or advisor to a zoning agency are eligible to receive a Lifetime Achievement award.

Please complete the enclosed nomination form for each commission member who meets the eligibility criteria and return by mail or e-mail to the above addresses on or before March 19, 2021. Award certificates for each recipient will be mailed to the nominating commission in April.
