This is to further confirm our strong opposition to any zone change from residential to commercial within the Middle Haddam Historic District as per PZCV-20-026 on the agenda for the March 3 meeting of East Hampton P&Z.

We must depend on you to exercise your right as a town commission to weigh in at this hearing. We feel it is incumbent upon you to do so to protect the integrity of the village boundaries. In 1976-77 we worked hard to be sure all of Long Hill and Keighley Pond were included within the district boundaries to prevent any commercial incursion into the district. This application is of no benefit to the Village of Middle Haddam and would present no hardship to the developer if denied.
