A. Town Council request for PZC application moratorium

5. Public Heatings:

A. PZC-24-003 Theodore Hintz Jr., 46 Keighley Pond Rd., Special Permit for Lighting of Outdoor Athletic facility for existing horse ring in R2 Zone. Map 01C/ Block 10/ Lot 11.

Vice-Chairman Zatorski made a motion to close the public hearing for PZC-24-003. The motion was seconded by Mr. Sennett. Vote: 6-0 in favor. Vice-Chairman Zatorski made a motion to approve the application PZC-24-003 for the following reasons: it meets their regulations; demonstration of lights was conducted April 24 & 25, 2024; lighting plans with lighting plot is within Town regulations. With the following modifications: post installation review by Town Staff and their determination for need for landscaping; reference photos of the lighting shall be submitted to Town Staff for file, and use is for only for residential, no commercial use; lighting be turned off by 9pm; applicant conduct a post-installation photometric analysis to verify that the proposed lighting did not spill onto adjacent properties and submit to Town Staff for review for possible adjustment.
