Ms. Susan Weintraub moved to adopt the resolution "To Appropriate \$200,000 from Unassigned General Fund Balance for Costs Associated with the East Hampton High School Athletic Field Lighting Project" seconded by Mr. George Pfaffenbach.

Moderator Maynard opened the meeting to discussion and comments.

Ruth Checker, Director of Parks & Recreation reiterated the scope of the project which included the design, construction and installation of lights on the main soccer field only. The project had been approved by Planning & Zoning, Board of Finance and Town Council prior to this town meeting.
