To discuss and vote upon a resolution to appropriate FIFTY FOUR THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY FOUR DOLLARS (\$54,974) for costs in connection with hiring an additional police officer for the Police Department; and the appropriation shall be funded from unassigned General Fund balance (\$54,974) and the amount of the appropriation shall be allocated as follows:

- \$41,073 (Patrol budget)
- \$13,901 (Health Insurance/Employee Benefits budget).

The appropriation may be spent on wages, benefits and other related expenses.

The Moderator requested that the resolution prepared for this item be presented.

Mrs. Patience Anderson presented the resolution to be considered under item 1 of the Notice, the full text of which resolution is attached to and made a part of these minutes, which resolution was seconded by Ms. Melissa Engel. The Moderator stated that the meeting was open for discussion of the foregoing resolution. The following comments were made:

Mr. George Coshow, 26 Shipyard Road, asked if the health insurance budgeted was for family coverage or a single employee.

Mr. Michael Maniscalco, Town Manager, indicated that the health insurance was budgeted for family coverage and would be reduced if the new employee only needed single coverage.
