Mrs. Barbara Moore moved to adopt the resolution "To Appropriate \$60,000 from Unassigned General Fund Balance for Costs Associated with the Chatham Historical Society Water Main Extension and Sanitary Sewer System

RESOLVED,

that the Town of East Hampton appropriate SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$60,000) from unassigned General Fund balance and transfer the same amount to the Capital Reserve Fund for costs associated with the installation of a water main extension and connection of a sanitary sewer system to serve the Chatham Historical Society located on Bevin Boulevard. The appropriation may be spent for design, construction, acquisition and installation costs, related work and improvements, equipment, furnishings, materials, architect, engineering, project management, construction management and other consultant fees, legal fees, administrative costs, and other expenses related to the project" seconded by Mr. Philip Visintainer.

Moderator McKinney opened the meeting to discussion and comments.

RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE \$60,000 FROM UNASSIGNED GENERAL FUND BALANCE FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE CHATHAM HISTORICAL SOCIETY WATER MAIN EXTENSION AND SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM
