LIMITED IN SUBJECT MATTER TO THE TRANSFER, SALE OR DISPOSITION OF STATE-OWNED OR STATE-CONTROLLED REAL PROPERTY OR
INTERESTS IN REAL PROPERTY IN ORDER FOR THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO REQUIRE A STATE AGENCY TO SELL, TRANSFER OR DISPOSE
OF ANY REAL PROPERTY OR INTEREST IN REAL PROPERTY THAT IS UNDER THE CUSTODY OR CONTROL OF THE AGENCY, AND (2) IF SUCH

PROPERTY IS UNDER THE CUSTODY OR CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE OR THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, THAT SUCH ENACTMENT OF LEGISLATION BE PASSED BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF THE TOTAL
