Call to order & Pledge of Allegiance

Public Remarks

Fran Klein, Bellevue Street, commented on the Board of Education inclusion in the Town Hall/Police Department. She asked what the Superintendent thought of the move and noted her concerns on the Board of Education being near the Police Department.

Reconsideration/Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Inclusion of Board of Education Programming for Town Hall/Police Department Project

A motion was made by Ms. Engel, seconded by Mr. Brown, to reconsider and discuss and take possible action to include the Board of Education in the Town Hall/Police Department programming. Voted (6-1) Mr. Hintz against.

A motion was made by Ms. Engel, seconded by Mr. Brown, to include the Board of Education in the Town Hall/Police Department project programming. Voted (5-2) Mr. Hintz and Mr. Piteo against.

Council members each reviewed their responses to the Town Manager evaluation. The results will be compiled and a single evaluation will be provided to the Town Manager prior to June 15th. A meeting will be held on Tuesday, June 20th at 6:30pm to discuss the evaluation.
